A NOTE FROM YOUR FRIENDS IN DIETARY

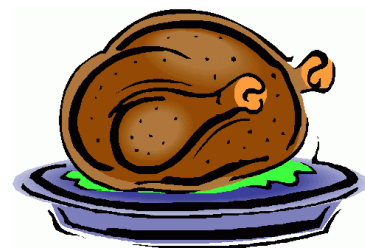
On behalf of the dietary department I would like to welcome all of the residents and their families who joined our home this month.

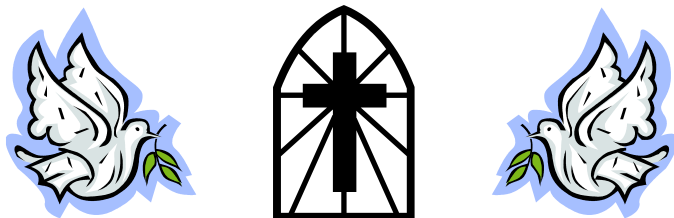
