It is hard to believe spring is just around the corner. As the weather improves, we will begin work on the outside grounds, in preparation for what hopefully will be a fantastic summer!





Special Request from your Care Department

Safe Medication Practice

Safe medication handling and administration is a very high priority for Registered Nursing staff to ensure the safety and comfort of the residents here at Centennial Place. Our medication pass times are 8:00 am, 12:00 noon, 4:00 pm, and 8:00 pm which coincide with mealtimes and bedtime. Not all medications are included in these times as care and medication administration are individualized to each resident. Medication passes can take anywhere from one to two hours to complete.

How can you help? During these times we are asking residents, family members, and fellow staff, to minimize non-urgent conversations, phone calls, and distractions with the Nurses to assist in promoting safe medication administration and optimize resident care.
